Sessions

We would like to draw your attention to the change in session section of our terms and conditions which states

"If you wish to decrease the number of sessions in attendance (including cancellation of your placement) a minimum of 1 terms notice is required. This should be notified within the first week of the term for changes to apply the following term."

If anyone needs to make a change for the spring 2014 term you will need to do so by Fri 13th Sept or else you will be liable for any shortfall in fees incurred by the pre-school including from Early Years funding.

Early Years Funding Forms.

For those of you whose child was three or over on 31 Aug 2013 you are entitled to receive up to 15 hours a week of Early Years Funding. The form to claim this funding will be ready for you to complete when you go back to pre-school. If your child turned three during the summer term you will have not claimed the funding before so you will also have a funding registration form to complete. It is imperative all forms are completed promptly as failure to do so may mean you do not meet the submission deadline and you will have to pay the fees - so please be prepared to spend five minutes at drop off completing the paperwork.
