Access to Policies and Procedures

In addition to the downloadable file on the website we will display the hard copy in the hall for the first 2 weeks of the year after which time it will be available for parents to view in the office.

Information about the Early Years Foundation Stage

In addition to the information already existing on the website, material, resources and ideas will be displayed at coffee mornings for different areas of learning. Parents will also be encouraged to discuss their child's progress towards the Early Learning Goals at drop off and pick up to share short-term targets.

Coffee Mornings

We will rotate the days on which group coffee mornings fall in order to increase the likelihood of parents being able to attend due to work commitments. Parents who are unable to attend are encouraged to have a discussion with their child's key person at their convenience e.g. at pick up time.

We will trial having one evening parents meeting and evaluate the effectiveness.

Hours and Term Dates

The opening hours and term dates of Rainbow's End are often reviewed at committee meetings (all parents are welcome to attend these meetings).

The start time of 9.15am was determined by the start time of Ewhurst CE Infant School and there being enough time for parents (and staff) to drop any siblings off at school before dropping off at Rainbow's End.

The finish time on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays was similarly chosen to give parents enough time to then collect siblings from school after picking up from Rainbow's End.

It would not be possible for Rainbow's End to run any later than 2.45pm due to the time it takes for staff to pack away before other users of the village hall arrive.

Rainbow's End is a term time community pre-school. Although the committee and managers do everything they can to accommodate the needs of working parents, the setting's ethos and missions statement is not that of a day care provider but aims to provide opportunities and an environment for children in Ewhurst and surrounding villages to develop in readiness for school.

At Rainbow's End, our aim is to provide a safe, happy, varied and stimulating environment. We offer your child the opportunity to learn and explore using a wide range of activities and equipment covering all areas of the curriculum, providing the best possible foundations for their future.

Ratios

In accordance with the majority opinion on the subject, Rainbow's End will continue to uphold the current ratio of 1:4 (2 year olds) and 1:8 (3 year olds) for this academic year at least.

Home Visits

Rainbow's End aims to trial home visits for one academic year to evaluate the effectiveness beginning with the January 2014 intake.
